




What is HomeGuard?


A subsidized program created to help prevent wastewater and stormwater from entering homes during heavy, localized rains.


HomeGuard is


- Affordable: Save up to \$15,000







FLAP FLOATS UP TO BLOCK BACKWATER


How does it work?


A one-way valve is installed that prevents sewage from public sewer systems from backflowing into homes.








Numbers So Far


Within the 536-home pilot area:

- 128 homes have applied (24%)
- 103 homes have scheduled or completed inspections
- 30 homes have completed or are pending installations
 - Appx 40% conversion rate



Applying For the Program

- Apply online oakgov.com/wrchomeguard.
- A program representative will call to schedule the initial inspection.
- The homeowner is required to pay a \$100 participation fee.
- Our inspection team will complete an evaluation of your home.
- If approved, the installation will be scheduled.
- The City of Berkley inspectors will complete a final inspection.
